Notes to Inventories Wanted!

1. Salmon inventories can be sought with Russian, Japanese owned fisheries in Alaska and Pacific area, whose primary intent is to collect salmon eggs for caviar production, and needing a "home" or market for the fish itself. A limited market for fish restricts their ability to catch more fish to collect more eggs, the more valuable part of the fish.
2. See the program notes titles "Truck Trailer Program" (TTP) for further details on the structure and operations of soliciting and receiving this bulky donation.
3. K-12 Books, College textbooks and General Topic Books. See additional program notes describing the solicitation, collection, and shipping of this inventory.
4. Lost and Damaged Freight is a common problem with trucking companies, freight forwarders, and couriers.
5. Hotel Rooms solicitation and program presentation notes are available by request.
6. Food ingredients can include:
Albumen, Almonds, Bakery Ingredients, Buttermilk Powder, Cake Toppings, Casein, Caseinates, Cashews, Cheese, Food Chemicals, Chocolate Chips, Cocoa Powders, Coatings, Colors, Coffee Concentrates, Confections, Juice Concentrates, Dairy Powders, Dried Fruits & Veggies., Dextrose, Dried Eggs, Fillings, Freeze-Dried Fruits, Freeze Dried Veggies., Frozen Fruits & Veggies., Fructose, Granola, Ice Cream Mixes, Jams & Jellies, Lecithin, Maltodextrin, Meats, Milk Powders, Nonfat Dry Milk, Nuts, Oils (including Cottonseed and Soybean), Peanuts & P. Butter, Peanuts, Proteins, Pumpkin Seeds, Raisins, Sauces, Seeds, Spices, Sucrose, Sugar, Sweeteners, Syrups, Tomato Products, Vanilla, Vitamins, Walnuts, Whey Protein Concentrates.
7. Whole industrial plants can include such processing plants as: dairy, bakeries, candy production, ethanol, cement, fruit freezing, fish meal, juice, latex, pharmaceutical, soybean processing, waste treatment, to mention just a few. To offer some more detail, a plastics processing plant equipment system being replaced might include: extruders, blow molding, blown film equipment. Production equipment pieces in various plants might include: kettles, tanks, reactors, filters, dryers, blowers, and grinders.
8. Construction equipment may include: bulldozers, backhoes, cranes, front end loaders, trucks, cement mixers, tractors, specialty trucks/trailers/equipment/tools, in a condition they can still be repaired and made useful.
9. Books. Request additional program notes describing solicitation, collection, and shipping of this kind of inventory. Remainders and hurts are books which are store and/or customer returns to distributors. Different sources of books require a variation in the approach for solicitation and collection, including K-12, College, and General Topic books.
